
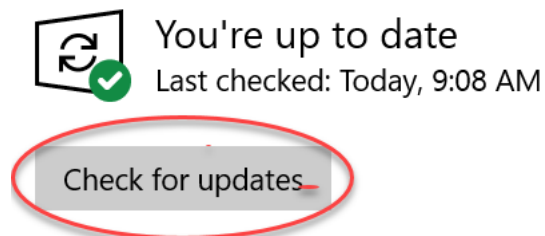


Windows 10 November 2019 Update is now available -- here's how to get it

This is a small update that focuses on "performance improvements, enterprise features and quality enhancements". You won't be offered it automatically however. If you want to install it you'll have to follow these steps.

1. Look at the very bottom-left of your screen and click on the search  symbol then type in: **Windows Update**.
2. If you see "**Windows optional update available**" click on "**download and install now**".
3. If you do not see the notice in step 1, click on **Check for updates**.

4. Once the update appears, select **Download and install now**.
5. Follow the installation process and reboot. You can schedule the restart for later if you prefer.

If the update doesn't appear when you check for it, it's possible that there's a compatibility issue with your PC. Most probably you have an old version of a Realtek Bluetooth driver. If so, [click here](#) for instructions from Microsoft if you wish to proceed.

If your machine is more than about 5 years old and is very slow to start up you may consider replacing it with a new one soon. You will be surprised how quickly a new machine runs!

With this update you'll be able to:

- Quickly create an event directly from the Calendar fly-out on the Taskbar.
- Better manage notifications, including a new button at the top of the Action Center and the ability to sort notifications by most recently shown.
- Integrate OneDrive content online with traditional indexed results in the File Explorer search box.
- Expand the navigation pane on the Start menu when you hover over it with your mouse to better inform where clicking goes.
- Use your voice to activate third-party digital assistants from the Lock screen.
